### **Discipleship: How to Obey Jesus' Command to Feed and Tend His Lambs and Sheep – Kyle Rapinchuk – Room 101**

Numerous passages of Scripture record Jesus' own teaching on discipleship. This breakout session will explore one such text, John 21, and Jesus' words to Peter. In response to Peter's assurances that he loves Jesus, Jesus' response is to give him work to do: feed and tend my lambs and sheep. These post-resurrection directives to Peter seem to suggest a particularly important task, but what does it mean to feed and tend Jesus' lambs and sheep? Join me as we explore the answer together.
